



Account Code Billing Services

Account Code Billing Services provide solutions for businesses to keep toll charges for their different departments separate for accounting purposes. IS offers three types of account code billing services.

Verified Account Code Service

When subscribers place toll calls using Verified Account Code Service, they are prompted for an account code. The code is verified against a list of valid codes for that telephone. Calls are completed using AIN AMA record generation so that your billing system can identify the the account code.

Account Codes can be administered by the subscriber using a Personal Identification Number (PIN) number. Or, telephone company personnel may maintain the account codes for the subscriber.

Non-Verified Account Code Service

When a subscriber places a toll call, they are prompted to enter an account code. The account code is checked only for correct number of digits and the call is placed without additional verification or authorization. Calls are completed using AIN AMA record generation so that your billing system can identify the account code.

Account Code PLUS

Account Code Plus gives business toll customers the ability to manage their account code system and additional originating call options directly and conveniently, from an Internet site that is powered by the Innovative Systems Internet Access (ISIA) System. As with Verified Account Code Service, when a user places a toll call, they are prompted to enter an account code, which is verified against predefined account code(s) valid for that caller.

Budget Toll

If a customer develops a history of partial or late payments, the Telco can place the customer on a limited monthly budget, instead of totally prohibiting their access to toll calling. New customers with no credit history or poor credit history can be offered toll on a limited basis. This reduces your company's risk of exposure and helps reduce bad debt write-offs.

AIN-Based Budget Toll

A subscriber to the AIN Budget Toll service is allotted a budgeted number of toll minutes per month. While time remains, the feature is transparent to the user. A call already in progress will not be disconnected when the allotted time has been used. Once the allotted time has been depleted, a subscriber attempting to place a toll call will receive an announcement stating that their time has expired and they will be unable to place the call.

Budget Toll with Disconnect

A Budget Toll with Disconnect service is also available for companies using the Nortel DMS-10 switch with Generic Release 504. This service will disconnect calls in progress when the allotted time is depleted.

Campus Toll Calling

Campus Toll Calling service is specifically designed for use on college campuses. It may also apply to other group situations where it is necessary to have multiple people use the same telephones and yet receive individual toll bills. You may bill monthly for the service, or you may administer the service on a pre-pay basis.

When making a toll call (from any campus telephone) the student is prompted to enter a Personal Identification Number (PIN) associated with their billing information. The PIN allows the Telco to bill the specific student for their calls. Campus Toll Calling offers fraud protection services as well as the ability to block specific types of calls (int'l, 900, etc.) on a PIN-by-PIN basis.

Do Not Disturb

Give your customers the quiet time they desire with the control to decide who has the ability to interrupt their "quiet time".

Do Not Disturb allows customers to define a time period when incoming calls are blocked. The defined time period defined is effective each day until the customer changes the time for the service. Customers can also disable calls for an entire day without affecting the regular time schedule.

Specific callers are allowed to complete calls during the quiet time if they know the override code or PIN.

Personal Billing

In situations where multiple parties share a single phone line (i.e. roommates), sorting out which phone calls belong to whom can be a nightmare. Personal Billing service eliminates that problem for the subscriber.

Personal Billing allows up to four users, each with a unique Personal Identification Number (PIN) to share a single telephone line and Directory Number. When placing toll calls, users are required to enter their PIN. Based on the capability of your company's billing system, each user receives a separate monthly bill for toll charges associated with their PIN.
